She was also picked as Mentor of the Year in 2011 while Associate Professor of Dermatology at Nova Southeastern University. Following residency, Dr. Combs completed a dermatopathology fellowship at Larkin Community Hospital in South Miami, FL.

Dr. Combs has received multiple industry awards and honors, and has been involved extensively in the dermatology community through serving on local committees, volunteering for community health events, and participating in several professional organizations. Her community service has been focused primarily around skin cancer prevention and awareness, and for several years her volunteer efforts have supported the Skin Cancer Screening at Miramar Dermatology, and Melanoma/Skin Cancer Screening Program at Broward Health Hospital. She was actively involved in Nova Southeastern University's annual "A Day for Children" health fair in 2007 and 2008, and participated in Spring Swing Moffitt's Sun Safety Tour skin cancer screening in 2009. Dr. Combs also served roles on departmental and administrative committees for Nova Southeastern University's College of Osteopathic Medicine and Broward General Medical Center, as well as several teaching and lecturer roles.
